**Mr. Chairman:** Now, we take up questions.

**Question No. 19** in the name of Khawaja Mohammad Safdar.

**ALLOCATION AND SUPPLY OF VEGETABLE GHEE AND SUGAR TO PROVINCES**

**19. \*Khawaja Mohammad Safdar (Put by Rao Abdus Sattar):** Will the Minister for Production, Industries, Environment and Urban Affairs be pleased to state the total quantity of Vegetable Ghee and Sugar allocated and supplied to each of the four Provinces separately during the year 1974-75, and during the months of July, August and September, 1975?

**Syed Qaim Ali Shah Jilani:** The information is given in the statement placed on the Table of the House (Annex-I).

Syed Qaim Ali Shah Jillani : I can answer him, if you allow.

جناب نعمت اللہ خاں شنواری : پاکستان کے چار ہی صوبے ہیں اور قبائلی علاقہ بھی پاکستان میں آتا ہے ۔

جناب چیئرمین : میری بات تو سنئیے ۔ آپ تشریف رکھیے ۔ آپ آداب مجلس سیکھیں ۔ خواجہ صاحب نے چاروں صوبوں کا پوچھا تھا ۔ انہوں نے بتا دیا ہے ۔ اب آپ کی شکایت ہے کہ انہیں ٹرائیبل ایریا کا بھی بتانا چاہیے تو اس لیے آپ سپلیمنٹری پوچھ سکتے ہیں ۔ اب آپ کھڑے ہو کر سوال پوچھ سکتے ہیں ۔

جناب نعمت اللہ خاں شنواری : کیا منسٹر انچارج ٹرائیبل ایریا کے متعلق بتا سکتے ہیں کہ کتنا کوٹہ ہر ایک ایجنسی کو دیا گیا ہے ؟

Syed Qaim Ali Shah Jillani : Sir, the quota for the provinces and the tribale areas as well as Azad Kashmir is decided in the Provincial Coordination Committee each year. Therefore, Sir, according to that decision which was taken latest on 15th November 74, the Position is that for tribale areas and Northern Areas.....

Mr. Chairman : Tribal areas is different from Northern Areas.

Syed Qaim Ali Shah Jillani : Sir, I have got figures for Azad Kashmir and Northern Areas.

Mr. Chairman : You have got figures for Northern Areas and Azad Kashmir but not for Tribal Areas ?

Syed Qaim Ali Shah : Yes, Sir.

**20. Khawaja Mohammad Safdar** (put by Rao Abdus Sattar) : Will the Minister-in-charge of Cabinet Division be pleased to state :

(a) whether Cabinet Division has prepared the annual report in relation to the Federation for the observance of the Principles of Policy for the year 1974-75 ; and

(b) if answer to (a) above be in the affirmative, whether he is prepared to place the said report on the Table of the House ?

**Major General (Retd) Jamal Dar :** It is under preparation and will be placed on the table of the House shortly.

**Mr. Chairman :** Next question.

**PROPOSED INDUSTRIES**

**21. Sardar Mohammad Aslam :** Will the Minister for Production, Industries, Environment and Urban Affairs be pleased to state:

(a) the number of Industries proposed to be set up in the current financial year in public sector in each province ;

(b) the number of the industries proposed in (a) above whose construction has already started ; and

(c) the number of industries set up so far in the current financial year in public sector in N.W.F.P. ?

**Mr. M. Rafi Raza :** (a and b) The projects under various stages of implementation are ;

Punjab : 7

Sind : 10

NWFP : 6

Baluchistan : 6

(c) Six projects are under implementation. One will come into production this year.

**Sardar Mohammad Aslam :** Supplementary, Sir.

جواب میں این ڈبلیو ایف پی کے ۶ پراجیکٹ بتائے گئے ہیں کیا ان ان پراجیکٹوں کے نام بتائیں جائیں گے ؟

**Mr. M. Rafi Raza :** Certainly, Sir. First is Hazara Fertilizer Complex, which will be an over 100 crores complex. Next is Dir Forest Industries Complex which is about 25 crores i.e. 250 lakhs. Third Tarbela is Cotton Textile Mills. Fourth is the Mustehkam Cement Project expansion three hundred thousand tons. Fifth is Swat Ceramic Complex which will soon be ready in the beginning of next year some time. And the 6th is proposed Mohmand Cement Project.

**Sardar Mohammad Aslam :** Supplementary, Sir.

**Mr. M. Rafi Raza :** Sir, this the last one Mohmand Cement Project has not even started so how could it have been there two three years ago and the Hazara Fertilizer Complex will be starting this year.

جناب چیئرمین : وہ کہتے ہیں کہ اصل کام شروع ہونے والا ہے۔

سردار محمد اسلم : کیا وزیر صاحب بتلائیں گے کہ جن پراجیکٹس پر کام شروع ہو گیا ہے ان کے علاوہ کوئی نئے پراجیکٹس زیر تعمیر موجودہ فنانشل ایئر میں این ڈبلیو ایف پی میں لگانے ہیں ؟

**Mr. M. Rafi Raza :** Sir, let me remind him that these projects are the Federal Government public sector projects. The Provincial Government has its own projects under the public sector. These are the projects we have got underway. Out of the six, four are actually under construction and the other two, as I said, the Kohat Cement Project has not been started yet.....

**Mr. Chairman :** His supplementary is besides these six which you have mentioned whether there are any more projects which have been sanctioned.

**Mr. M. Rafi Raza :** I cannot make wrong statement. He says, besides six if there may be more. Now, if there may be more, I would have put it in the answer.

**Mr. Chairman :** His supplementary is whether are there any other projects under consideration.

**Mr. M. Rafi Raza :** Sir, that is not part of the question. It does not form part of the question. He can ask for these six, Sir.

سردار محمد اسلم : یہ میرا سوال تھا - سوال کی حجامت یہاں کی گئی ہے -

**Mr. Chairman :** No, no. You are reading something, which is not there. Are You reading (c) ?

سردار محمد اسلم : یہ (اے) پڑھ رہا ہوں -

(a) Number of industries proposed to be set up in the current financial year in public sector in each province ;

(b) Number of industries proposed in (a) above whose construction has already started ; and

(c) Number of industries proposed to be set up by the Federal Government in the remaining period of current financial year.

**Mr. M. Rafi Raza :** We have projects always under consideration and the two projects : as I said, are the Hazara Fertilizers and Kohat, and the question as given to me does not say what else and we don't like just to throw out the projects until the projects are considered properly, approved, sanctioned. We can't just say we have got. We have many things under consideration.

**Mr. Afzal Khan Khoso :** Supplementary, Sir. Would the honourable Minister be pleased to give the Division-wise break up of industries proposed in Sind ?

**Mr. M. Rafi Raza :** Sir, I can tell him the exact location but I may not be able to tell him exactly where the Divisions are. Sir, three of them are, in fact, related to the National Refinery. They are part of petrochemicals. So, these will be located in Karachi where the National Refinery is situated. One is going to be the Fertilizers Factory in Mirpur Mathelo ; one is the expansion of the Javedan Cement Factory, the former Valika, which is outside Karachi. Then there is the Karachi Steel Mills, of course, a big national project. Then there is at Gharo a castic Soda expansion in the existing. This is run-down and location of the projects.

سردار محمد اسلم : سوال کا جواب یہ دیا ہے :

In part (c) : Six projects are under implementation. One will come into production this year.

کیا بتلائیں گے کہ کون سے پراجیکٹ اس سال شروع کریں گے ؟

**Mr. M. Rafi Raza :** This year means this financial year. Swat Ceramics at Nowshera. It will come into production in the financial year and not in the calendar year.

**Rao Abdus Sattar :** Supplementary, Sir. Will the Minister for Production be pleased to mention the names of proposed industries established in the Punjab ?

**Mr. M. Rafi Raza :** Sir, there is the Multan Pak-Arab Fertilizers Factory. I will repeat this. These are the projects under the Board of Industrial Management, under the Ministry of Production. The Ministry of Fuel and Power has its own and the Provincial Government has its own, while the Ministry of Communications has its own. So, it should not be misunderstood that these are all the projects that are being set up in the public sector. So, one is the Multan Pak-Arab Fertilizers Factory at a cost of over hundred crores. Next is spinning machinery project. Its location is still to be decided. Then there is Bākeziest Plant, which will go in the part of our Kala Shah Kaku Complex. Then there is the Melatheon Project, which again will go as a part of our Kala Shah Kaku Complex. Then there is a PVC Pipe Project, which is in Islamabad. There is a Heavy Foundry and Forge at Taxila and a Heavy Electrical Complex, which is at Taxila.

**Mr Chairman :** Supplementaries have come from Frontier, have come from Punjab, have come from Sind. What about Baluchistan ?

**Mr Tahir Mohammad Khan :** Sir, these are the projects which have been coming on the papers for so many years, and everything has been thrashed out, and I think most of our Members here know some of the important projects.

**Mr. Chairman :** All right. Now, next question.

**Mr. Qaim Ali Shah Jillani :** The question is of total industries. There is no distinction mentioned in the question about heavy, medium size or small size industries. So, we have given the total of this year's sanctioned industries in which there are heavy industries also and small industries as well.

سردار محمد اسلم : شاہ صاحب کو شاید میں مقصد نہیں سمجھا سکا۔ میرے کہنے کا مقصد یہ تھا کہ modernisation کے لیے آخری جو آپن ہیں وہ تو ٹھیک ہے یہ نئے جو sanction ہوئے ہیں۔ ۱۹۶۹ کاٹن انڈسٹریز میں تناسب looms کا ہے۔ میں پوچھنا یہ چاہتا تھا کہ آیا ہیوی یا میڈیم انڈسٹری کے لیے اہلائی کسی نے نہیں کیا یا sanction نہیں ہوئی۔ کیونکہ بیچاری میں تقریباً۔

Out of 32, Sir, I think about 25 or 27 are only looms?

**Mr. Qaim Ali Shah Jillani :** Textile industry is not a loom, Sir. Textile industry, after all, is not a small industry. There are mostly textile units which are sanctioned.

**Mr. Chairman :** No further supplementary ?

#### MESSAGE FROM THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY RE : ADOPTION OF THE CUTTING OF TREES (PROHIBITION) BILL, 1975

THE CRIMINAL LAW (AMENDMENT) BILL, 1975

**Malik Mohammad Akhtar :** Sir, I beg to introduce a Bill further to amend the Pakistan Penal Code and the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1898. [The Criminal Law (Amendment) Bill, 1975].

**Mr. Chairman :** The Bill stands introduced. No other business ?

**Mr. Chairman :** So, at what time should we meet tomorrow ?

**Voices :** Ten O'clock.
