Gentlemen, on this occasion I would like to make one remark in particular, and it is this that we have always co-operated with each other, as I said on a previous occasion, and today this morning too that the Members of this House have been working with each other as members of the same team. They have been fully co-operating with each other, they have respect for each other, and they have great regard for each other. In his time as a Deputy Chairman, I am sure, he would also bear this in mind, and try to do justice not only between a Member and a Member, but between different groups also, if the Opposition also happens to come here which we are missing today. I am sure that he will follow in the steps of his predecessor in office, Mr. Tahir Mohammad Khan. With these remarks, in the end, I again congratulate him for being elected unanimously as Deputy Chairman of this House.
