



RESOLUTION NO. 276

"The Senate of Pakistan strongly condemns the cruel and barbaric act of terrorism in Quetta on 8th August, 2016 and expresses deep sorrow over the killing of more than 60 lawyers including the son of Senator Dr. Jehanzeb Jamaldini and other innocent people in the gruesome incident.

The terrorists again perpetuated other cowardly attacks on the District Courts and lawyers in Mardan and the Christian Community in Peshawar.

The Senate of Pakistan expresses its deep sorrow and grief over the sad incidents and shows solidarity with the families of the victims and prays for the early recovery of the injured.

The House expresses heart felt grief with Senator Dr. Jehanzeb Jamaldini and his family on loss of his son in the incident.

The Senate of Pakistan stands side by side with the lawyers' community, civil society, law enforcement agencies and journalists on this occasion of grief and loss sustained by them and shows solidarity and full support to defeat the terrorist elements in achieving their illicit objectives and calls upon the Federal Government and the Governments of Balochistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa as well as the law enforcement agencies to deal with such elements with iron hands.

The Senate of Pakistan resolves that such cruel / cowardly incidents of terrorism cannot shake the determination and commitment of this nation against the terrorism.
