



### RESOLUTION NO.40

The House records its deep appreciation and satisfaction at the historic elections in South Africa, which have paved the way for a multi-racial coalition Government. The elections in South Africa have also resulted in a victory for the African National Congress (ANC) under the dynamic leadership of Nelson Mandela.

While congratulating the people of South Africa for joining the comity of democratic nations through a peaceful and successful transition to a multi-racial Government, the house would also like to place on record its strong appreciation and respect for the valour, determination, perseverance and tenacity which the people of South Africa demonstrated during their long struggle against the hated system of apartheid.
