



RESOLUTION NO.42

"It is a matter of very grave concern and anxiety for the Muslim Ummah in general and for Pakistanis in particular that under a conspiracy, the Muslim enclave of Behac has been allowed to be captured and 80,000 Muslims there have been left at the mercy of the Serb terrorists. The UN/NATO and the International Community are totally oblivious of the grave situation. Muslims are being subjected to genocide and the respect and honour of thousands of Muslim women is being outraged. The acts of terrorism of the Serbs against Muslims now and in the past find no parallel in the annals of contemporary history.

This House condemns in strongest terms, these inhuman, barbaric and dastardly acts of killings, violence, burning, looting, arson, rapes and the outraging the modesty of Muslim women and demands that the UN/NATO and the world's conscience should be shaken and asked to enforce and implement the UN resolutions, norms of fair play. We further demand that OIC Countries should immediately meet to evolve strategy to meet this emergency and ensure the safety and security of the Bosnian Muslim who are victims of a planned campaign of extermination.
