



### RESOLUTION NO.43

**"Outraged, by the wanton and inhuman desecration and destruction of the historical shrine of Hazrat Nooruddin Wali and the mosque and Madrasa at Charar-e-Sharif along with holy relics by the Indian occupation forces,**

**Strongly condemning, this destruction of holy places and thousands of homes and massacre of innocent Kashmiri men, women and children,**

**Holding Government of India and its occupation forces fully responsible for this horrible act,**

**Deploring the threats brandished by the Indian leaders against Pakistan and remaining undeterred and fully resolved to resist and provide befitting response to such threats,**

**This House strongly condemns the desecration and demolition of the holy shrine, the mosque, and Madrasa at Charar-e-Sharif; and the cowardly, savage and inhuman attempts by the Government of India to crush the Kashmiri people by unleashing and an unprecedented reign of terror, rape and pillage,**

**Extending, its heartfelt condolences to the families of the martyred Kashmiri people; urges the United Nations Human Rights Commission and the ICRC to visit and see for themselves the human right violations resulting in massive loss of life and property, with the purpose of arranging international relief and rehabilitation of the affected Kashmiri people,**

**Salutes the valiant people of Kashmir especially the Mujahideen and their glorious struggle for freedom,**

**Pledges, Pakistan's continued moral, political and diplomatic support to the people of the occupied state of Jammu and Kashmir resistance; and express complete solidarity with their just struggle for the right of self-determination promised to them by the United Nations including India,**

This House calls upon the international community to prevail on India to seek a just and honourable solution of the Jammu and Kashmir dispute by implementing its international obligation of holding a free, fair and impartial plebiscite in accordance with the United Nations Security Council resolutions."
