



RESOLUTION NO.44

"The Senate of Pakistan condemns in strongest terms the Rocket attack on a mosque in Forward Kahuta, (AK) as a result of which 18 people were killed; a large number of people seriously injured and the Holy mosque totally gutted, where these people had gathered to offer Friday prayers.

This is yet another example of the aggressive and criminal attitude of India, which is a grave threat to the peace of the region.

This should be sufficient to open the eyes of the World community before whom India has been trying parade as the so called biggest democracy but with this black record also making desperate efforts to gain a permanent seat in the security council.

The world opinion, especially those who have a stake in the world peace and justice should put their weight for the resolution of the Kashmir issue as decided by the resolutions of the United Nations."
