



### RESOLUTION NO.47

"The Senate of Pakistan has observed with profound concern the oppressive policies being followed by the Israeli government in the Palestinian territories and particularly in Al-Quds Al Sharif (Jerusalem). It deploras the tragic loss of life of the Palestinians at the hands of Israeli security forces.

This House reiterates the significance and sanctity of the holy Al-Aqsa Mosque for the people of the Islamic Ummah. The recent opening of a tunnel in close proximity to one of Islam's holiest places not only exposes the false Israeli commitment to the maintenance of religious and cultural sites but is also incompatible with the peace process.

This House calls for reversal of all illegal measures taken by the Israeli authorities vis-a-vis the Islamic holy sites as well as against the unarmed civilian population of the occupied territories.

This House also calls upon the international community to play its due role in restoration of peace, stability and security to the region, based on the inviolable rights of the peoples concerned.
