



### RESOLUTION NO.59

"The Senate of Pakistan expresses its shock and dismay over the attack by the U.S., British and allied forces against Iraq in clear violation of the U.N. Charter.

The Senate strongly deplores the military attack against Iraq by use of indiscriminate firepower against innocent Iraqi civilians and demands that the U.N. Security Council must take an immediate initiative to stop hostilities and seek a peaceful and diplomatic solution to the problem.
