



### **RESOLUTION NO.80**

*“The Senate of Pakistan expresses its shock and horror on the atrocities committed by the US Forces of occupation in Abu Ghraib in Iraq as evidenced in the photographs shown on Australian TV on its “Dateline” Programme. These insulting photographs were not allowed to be shown in the United States. The Senate condemns these crimes against humanity and endorses the demands made by the United Nations Human Rights Committee and the Amnesty International to punish all persons responsible for these crimes and ensure complete abidance of the Geneva Conventions in Iraq, Guantanamo Bay and other places where prisoners of war are being held.”*
