



RESOLUTION NO.82

“This House views with grave concern the unwarranted observations of some members of the US House of Representatives wherein they have demanded the handing over of Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan for interrogation and inquiries about Pakistan’s nuclear program.

We term this action as blatant violation of Pakistan’s sovereignty and integrity, and interference in our internal affairs. Pakistan’s nuclear program is vital for our defence and is not directed against any one. Further, Pakistan is a responsible nuclear state and is fully cognizant of its responsibilities in international politics.

We condemn in no uncertain terms the character assassination of Dr. Abdul Qadeer Khan and other scientists, which is an attempt to malign Pakistan’s nuclear program. Our scientists enjoy the respect and appreciation of all Pakistanis. Our nation is indebted to them for the remarkable progress that our country has made in the field of nuclear technology, weapons development and energy security.”
