



## **RESOLUTION NO.92**

"The Senate of Pakistan:

Recalling the ongoing Composite Dialogue between Pakistan and India to resolve all outstanding issues including Jammu and Kashmir;

Recalling further the unrest over the issue of allocation of land to the Shri Amarnath Shrine Board;

Noting with regret the recent reports of an economic blockade imposed by the Hindu extremists against the Muslims of Jammu and the Valley of Kashmir;

Concerned over the tension and fear that has gripped the entire Muslim population of Jammu and Kashmir arising out of attacks on Muslims and their properties in Jammu city, Rajouri, Poonch, Udhampur, Riasi, Samba, Doda and Kathua, damage to mosques, blockade of Srinagar Jammu Highway to stop trucks from transporting essential commodities including life saving drugs to the Valley of Kashmir;

**Expresses** its deep concern over the continuing economic blockade of the Kashmir Valley by the Hindu extremists;

**Expresses further** its concern over the attacks on Muslims and their properties by the Hindu extremists;

**Calls** for immediate steps to address the situation and stop the gross human rights violations being committed against the innocent Kashmiris;

**Reaffirms** the diplomatic and political support of the people and the Government of Pakistan to the Kashmiri people in their struggle to achieve their rights, including the right to self-determination.

**Calls** for an early just and peaceful settlement of Jammu and Kashmir dispute in accordance with relevant UN Resolutions and aspirations of the Kashmiri people."
