



RESOLUTION NO.131

"This House unanimously:

Condemns in the strongest terms the incidents of brutal killings of anti-polio vaccinators (health workers) in Karachi and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and causing injuries to workers on 18th and 19th December, 2012.

Demands that all the culprits be arrested and expeditious prosecution be initiated in order to bring the culprits to book and they are awarded due punishment.

An appropriate amount of compensation be paid to the heirs of the victims and also to the injured workers of the polio campaign.

The campaign to eradicate the menace of polio in the country should continue with full force without any hindrance whatsoever.

The Federal Government and Provincial governments should ensure proper protection and security to all personnel engaged in polio eradication campaign for the efficacy and successful completion of the polio campaign to safeguard our children against the menace of polio in our country."
