



RESOLUTION NO.142

“The bloody crackdown on protestors by Egypt’s military rulers is strongly condemned. The use of force against unarmed civilians has resulted in loss of innocent lives of over 500 people in Cairo and other cities is indeed a tragic event.

The military regime should ensure that legal and constitutional issues are addressed through a dialogue amongst all parties, in an inclusive and peaceful manner to enable the country to successfully restore the democratic institutions as early as possible. In this they should learn from the Pakistani example in which a peaceful transition of power from one democratic Government to another has taken place.

We cannot hold back support for the rights of any people to do politics within a democratic framework and not be persecuted at the hands of military dictators.”
