



RESOLUTION NO. 591

“**WHEREAS** the alarming increase in the use of drugs among students in schools and colleges poses a serious threat to the physical and mental well-being of our youth;

WHEREAS the youth represents the future of our nation and the growing trend of drug use is pushing them towards moral and social destruction;

The Senate of Pakistan, therefore, recommends, that the Government should take immediate and concrete steps to curb the spread of drugs in educational institutions;

The Senate of Pakistan also urges upon the Government to coordinate with the Provincial Governments and make a comprehensive national strategy to eliminate usage of drugs from academic institutions.”
