



RESOLUTION NO. 595

“WHEREAS the people of Pakistan commemorate the 78th anniversary of their independence with pride, gratitude, and a renewed sense of responsibility towards the ideals upon which the nation was founded;

WHEREAS the creation of Pakistan was the culmination of decades of political struggle, sacrifices, and unwavering determination led by the Father of the Nation, Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah, and supported by countless freedom fighters, political leaders, scholars, poets, and ordinary people, whose steadfast commitment made the dream of a sovereign homeland a reality;

WHEREAS the Senate of Pakistan recognizes and pays special tribute to the distinguished parliamentarians and statesmen who, through wisdom, foresight, and untiring dedication, gave the country its Constitution, carried forward democratic reforms, and upheld the principles of parliamentary supremacy, the rule of law, and the protection of fundamental rights;

WHEREAS the Senate of Pakistan acknowledges the courage, professionalism, and sacrifices of Pakistan’s Armed Forces, police and other law enforcement agencies in safeguarding the sovereignty, integrity, and security of the nation;

WHEREAS the sacrifices of the martyrs (Shuhada) and the courage of the Ghazis form the bedrock of Pakistan’s freedom, and their legacy continues to inspire the nation’s resolve to protect its independence and dignity;

WHEREAS the resilience of the people of Pakistan, in overcoming political, economic, and natural challenges, reflects their unity of purpose and determination to build a peaceful, inclusive, and prosperous state in line with the vision of the founding fathers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of Pakistan:

1. **Solemnly commemorates** the 78th Independence Day, honoring the leadership of Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah and paying homage to all those whose sacrifices made Pakistan a sovereign and independent nation.

2. **Pays special tribute** to the parliamentarians who framed the Constitution of Pakistan and advanced democratic reforms, reaffirming commitment to preserving parliamentary democracy, constitutional supremacy, and the rule of law.
3. **Extends heartfelt congratulations** to all Pakistanis, at home and abroad, reaffirming commitment to the unity, sovereignty, and territorial integrity of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.
4. **Acknowledges and commends** the Armed Forces and security institutions for their unmatched valor and sacrifices in defending the nation.
5. **Honors** the martyrs and Ghazis, pledging to preserve and uphold their legacy for future generations.
6. **Reaffirms** adherence to the principles enshrined in the Constitution of Pakistan and the democratic vision of the founding fathers.
7. **Commits** to promoting peaceful coexistence, regional stability, and constructive engagement with neighboring countries and the global community to address shared challenges including climate change, economic inequality, terrorism, and public health crises, while safeguarding Pakistan's sovereignty.
8. **Calls upon** all citizens, particularly the youth, to unite beyond personal and political differences, and to contribute actively to nation building through education, innovation, civic engagement, and service to humanity.
9. **Pledges** to strive for sustainable development, economic empowerment, and national unity so that Pakistan may continue to stand as a beacon of hope, dignity, and progress in the comity of nations.

RESOLVED FURTHER that on this Independence Day, the Senate of Pakistan reaffirms its solemn dedication to protecting the sovereignty of the country, preserving its democratic ethos, and building a prosperous future for generation to come and congratulate the Nation on the great achievements and success of Marka-i-Haq.”
