



RESOLUTION NO. 602

“The Senate of Pakistan, being the House of the Federation:

- Strongly condemns the heinous suicide attack carried out in Islamabad on 6th February, 2026, which targeted innocent civilians and resulted in tragic loss of lives and injuries.
- Expresses deepest condolences and sympathy with the families of the victims and prays for the speedy recovery of those injured.
- Deplores the targeting of civilians and public places, including religious gatherings, and affirms that such acts are against the values of Islam, humanity, and the Constitution of Pakistan.
- Pays tribute to the prompt response and professionalism of law-enforcement agencies, emergency responders, and medical personnel who acted under challenging circumstances.
- Calls upon the Government to ensure a thorough, transparent, and time-bound investigation and to bring the perpetrators, facilitators, and sponsors of terrorism to justice in accordance with law.
- Urges the strengthening of intelligence coordination and security arrangements, particularly in the Federal Capital and other sensitive locations.
- Reaffirms the unwavering resolve of the State and the people of Pakistan that terrorism shall be defeated and national unity, peace, and stability shall be preserved at all costs.
- This House Demands the Government and the relevant institutions to immediately establish a judicial commission for a transparent, comprehensive and timely investigation into this incident, and to present its report to this House within four weeks. The members of the Judicial Commission should include retired senior judges from the Supreme Court, intelligence agencies, as well as representatives from the Ministry of Interior, the National Assembly and the Senate.”
